## Ready, Set, Learn

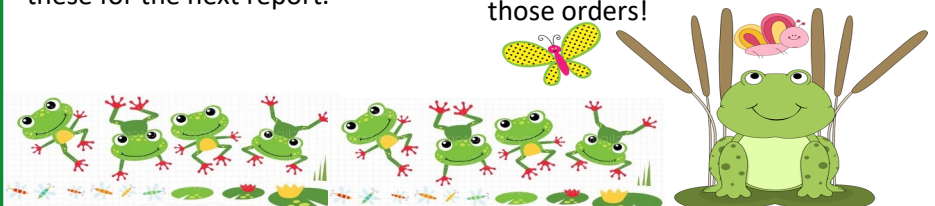

## Church Community Garden Project



You may have noticed some interesting construction at the end of the parking lot. The Vernon SDA Church has planned and is developing a Community Garden on the church property at the west end of the parking lot, transforming a vacant lot into a shared piece of land for people to gather together, to learn about gardening and to add beauty to the neighbourhood. We want to empower people to grow their own food while fostering an appreciation for the beauty of nature. There will be 12 (4'x 8') raised garden boxes (more proposed for 2022) and a seating/gathering area, which will be monitored daily, and be open to church/school/community families for an annual membership fee of \$30. Our hope is that through the garden we will make connections with neighbours, build up the sense of community and help educate people about sustainability.

While we are blessed to have donations of some materials, we are still in need of monetary donations (tax receipt available), VOLUNTEERS for a variety of jobs and time commitments (some minimal, some greater), men with trucks and other resources.
