Flower Basket Fundraiser



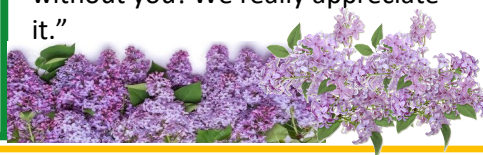
In a couple of days, the flower baskets will be here for picking up. Be sure to let your people know that it is first come, first choose their baskets.
