Drivers Abstracts & Volunteer Opportunities

- If you are able and willing to VOLUN-TEER at the school and you haven't volunteered before, we will need you to come into the office and sign a Statutory Declaration.
 You will also need a
 Criminal Record Check.
 You can submit it online for free through the school. Instructions are in our Welcome letter and available at the office.
- If you are able to DRIVE for upcoming field trips, we will need 1) the above 2 items, 2) a copy of your <u>driving ab-</u> <u>stract</u>. 3) And a copy of your <u>vehicle</u> <u>insurance</u> showing a minimum of \$2,000,000 liability.
