You will see our school information at this point

Follow the directions

When you are finished, print off the Confirmation page and please let us know what date we should be expecting the results.

Sometimes, it will not process it completely, If so, Please print off the final result, sign it and bring it to the school. We will have another form that you will need fill out here, which we will have to send in for you.
