**Registration Fees were due the first day of school.**

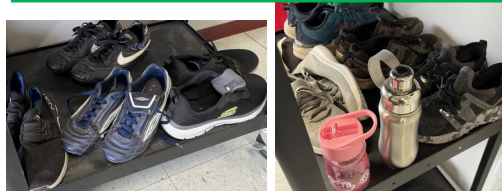
