Vision Screening

It is established that 1 in every 15 children has a vision problem. The Vernon Lions Club hopes you will allow your child to take part in the "Your Vision is Our Vision" project. The screening detects vision issues such as:

- Astigmatism
- Myopia
- Hyperopia
- Anisometropia
- Strabismus
- Anisocoria

The referral process is confidential.

You may fill out a form to indicate you do not want your child screened on **November 3.** Forms went home October 6.
